PROGRAM NOTES

The music of Alfred Reed (1921–2005) needs no introduction, especially to those who have experienced and long admired his distinguished works for concert band.

During his tenure at the University of Miami (Florida), Reed wrote a set of 28 variations (in ten short movements) on the children's song "London Bridge Is Falling Down" for brass quintet (2 trumpets, horn, trombone, and tuba). While this exercise could be considered an academic compendium of compositional techniques practiced during the past three centuries, the real value of the work lies in its captivating and highly musical moments.

This arrangement for concert band draws from five movements of Variations on L. B. I. F. D., in the following order:

- "Statement"
- "Waltz"
- "March Fo(u)rth!"
- "A Little Funeral Music, Please (Eine Kleine Trauermusik)"
- "Finale"

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Care has been taken to select sections from Reed's original work that present a balanced and entertaining concert piece, while at the same time remaining faithful to the skill level parameters for the Young Band series.

Even though players will encounter a few changes in tonal centers, meters, and tempo throughout, there is not much that would get in the way of the main objective of this title—having a fun experience learning and performing.
