- Other Instruments:** Trumpets (Trp.), Horns (Horn), Euphonium (Euph.), Tuba, Sub Bass (S.B.), and Timpani (Timp.) parts are present but mostly silent on this page.
- Dynamic Markings:** *p* (piano), *mf* (mezzo-forte), and *pp* (pianissimo).
- Performance Instructions:** *def. Bassoon* (define Bassoon) is written above the A. Sx. part.
